

THE CTLTC ELROD, GRAVES AND CTLTC LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP - APPLICATION

THE PURPOSE:

These scholarships are designed by the Central Texas Leadership Training for Christ Board to recognize young people who consistently demonstrate leadership qualities in their church, school and community. These awards are based on a student's good Christian example, financial need and proven leadership qualities. Only High School seniors who are registered and attending students in the current CTLTC Convention can apply for these scholarships.

There are three \$1,000 scholarships awarded (the Elrod, Graves and CTLTC scholarships). The Scholarships will be forwarded to the Admission's (scholarships) department of the school of choice at CTLTC's receipt of student Proof of Enrollment.

THE QUALIFICATIONS:

A committee of three individuals, including a current CTLTC board member, administers the scholarships to be awarded each year to three best qualified young people. Since the committee cannot know the personal life of each applicant, this scholarship becomes a "paper driven" event.

Evaluation of the student's leadership qualifications is based on the information provided by that student. Since the scholarship is awarded for leadership, each student should demonstrate their leadership characteristics through the papers they submit.

While membership in school groups or organizations, participation in church activities, involvement in worship services and outstanding moral character are wonderful indicators of leadership, they **do not completely define leadership**. The CTLTC scholarship committee is interested in both the student's perspective of leadership and how others perceive those qualities in his/her life.

In addition to this form, each student will submit the following:

- an essay defining your perception of leadership; examples of these leadership qualities in your daily life, your church life, your school life and your community life; and, how your faith and your character have been affected by these leadership qualities this year
- an essay describing one leadership event in your life and the resulting impact this event has made in your life
- a letter from an elder at your church commenting on the leadership skills he has witnessed in your life
- a letter from a community leader commenting on the leadership skills they have witnessed in your life
- a letter from your parent, or guardian, describing how this scholarship will benefit your education
